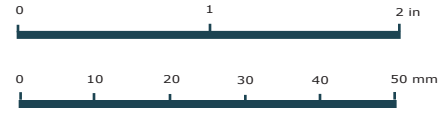


IMPORTANT: Ensure that the printed paper size is up to correct scale.

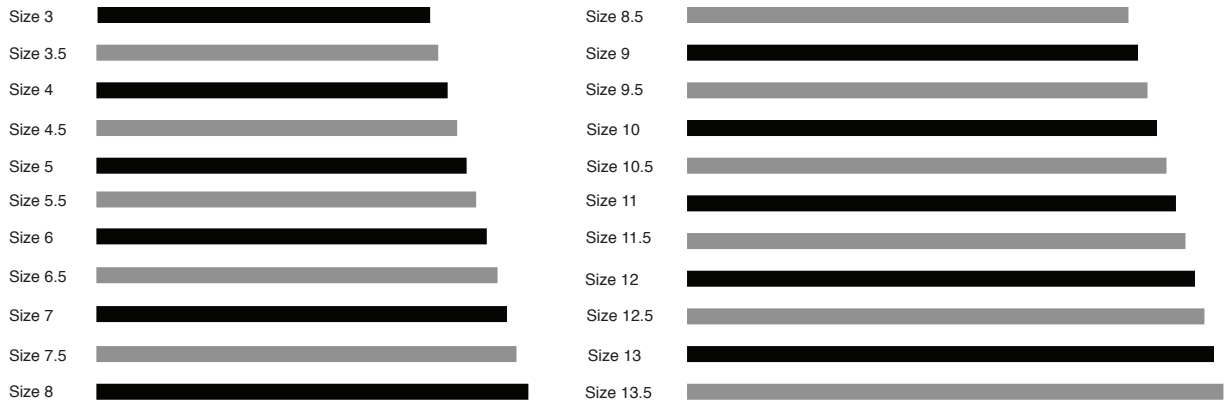
1. When printing, ensure that print page scaling is set to "NONE" on your print dialog box.
2. With a ruler measure the bar on the right to ensure it is exactly 2 inches, or 50 mm.

Confirm Printed Paper Size



Method A - Measure Finger With String

1. Find a piece of non-stretchy string about 6" long, or a strip of paper about 6" long and 1/4" wide.
2. Wrap it snugly around the base of your finger.
3. Using a pen, mark the point on the string or paper where it overlaps, forming a complete circle.
4. Compare the length of the string or paper to the lines on the paper below to determine your ring size. If you are between sizes, order the larger size.



Method B - Measure Existing Ring

1. Select a ring that properly fits the intended finger.
2. Place the ring over the circles below, matching the inside edge of the ring to the circle nearest in size. This measurement refers to the "inside diameter" of the ring.
3. If the ring falls between two sizes, order the larger size.
